"Gaza: Cruelty, Invisibility, Indifference?"

How much longer can the world stay indifferent to the massive cruelty toward the people of Gaza?

Israel's imposition of a punitive six year long siege and its indiscriminate use of violence against a defenceless civilian population are violations of the Geneva Conventions and classed as war crimes.

But Israel in association with its close ally the USA, and the collusion of other governments, is not held accountable. Who cares and what can the international community do?

This Friday at Politics in the Pub, Cathy Peters and Stuart Rees will analyse the present situation in Gaza and discuss how Australians can demand an end to this cruelty.

They say, 'We want to make the 800,000 children and 900,000 adults of Gaza, 100 times more visible than they are in Australian commentaries on the Israel/Palestine conflict.'

'The public need to know the extent of human rights abuses occurring right now and our media needs the courage to tell this story.'

Join Peters and Rees as they consider the extent and consequences of the siege of Gaza and look at future scenarios for a just peace in this region.
